QUESTIONS FOR YOU & GROUP

1. Which characters stood out to you most? Which were most interesting? Most moving?
2. Obeying God isn't always easy. To obey God often requires an adjustment to our comfortable situation, and sometimes brings opposition from those we care about. Discuss the different ways the characters in this episode reacted to Jesus' instruction. What were some of the consequences they faced in order to follow Jesus?
3. Jesus mentions several times that he's not trying to make the lives of his followers "easy", nor is he there to deliver them from their oppressive government. What was Jesus' purpose in coming? How was his purpose different than the one they expected?
4. Who were the first ones to be told about Jesus' birth? Who were the first ones that He told about His ministry? Was it surprising to you who He chose to tell first?
5. What was the significance of Jesus choosing to talk to a Samaritan woman? How can we model that today?
6. Has there ever been a time in your life when you were as excited about Jesus as the woman at the well was? How can you bring back some of that excitement?
